## DEAR FRIENDS

**M**any of you will have seen the figure representing John Wesley preaching to his flock on the green outside the Pack Horse. There is also a commemorative stone on the green to remind us just how long is the history of Methodism in Seaton. It can trace its roots back to 1752 during one of the preaching tours carried out by the great man himself. One of the reasons Wesley came to West Cumbria is that he sailed from Whitehaven when travelling to Ireland. The Methodist Chapel also has a very long and colourful story and you may have come to the event marking its 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary. It was in 2010 and one of the members, dressed as Wesley, rode on horseback to the Chapel for a wonderful and well-attended thanksgiving service. However the world is constantly changing and we need to remind ourselves that this is how God planned and designed his creation. All things have their day and the old must give way so that new and exciting things can appear. The Chapel at Seaton was badly affected by the loss of the ladies choir and then, in December last year, with the closing of the Seaton Sisterhood. Both struggling to continue with declining numbers and too few leaders. The Church itself has had the same struggle and now has reached the decision that it will cease to hold acts of

worship at the end of this year. As you can imagine this has been a very painful decision-making process and has not been taken without heartfelt consideration. Of course, all baptisms which have been booked for the remainder of this year will be honoured and we are looking forward to them. The Church contains important items, not least the modern chairs, most of which have been bought with donations from friends and members of the community and we will ensure that all such items are dispersed according to the wishes of our benefactors. The building will be maintained after worship has finished and so there will be time to do this properly. In the coming months the Church intends to hold acts of worship to celebrate and give thanks for a very full and rich 160 years, and also marking the great affection that it has enjoyed from the Seaton village community.

May God bless you for the future.
